

2-MINUTE SHOWS

Everyone has something to say, but can you say it in two minutes? Here is your chance to take the stage and share your work in 120 seconds.

Whether it be a self-running photo slideshow or a short video, the choice is yours as long as you stay within the 2-minute timeslot.

2-minute Show Guidelines

1. We will be accepting 2-minute shows on a first-come, first-served basis. No shows will be accepted after 10 a.m. on Saturday morning. The 2-minute shows will begin Friday evening.
2. You have a maximum of two minutes. After 120 seconds, your presentation will be cut off, so please pay close attention to the time limit.
4. Your multimedia self-running presentation (in photo slideshow or video format) must be in a self-contained file on a flash drive that can be copied onto another computer. Be sure your presentation is compatible for both Mac and PC computers.

Formatting Guidelines

1. All images should be sized at 72 dpi and no more than 10 inches. Image size for self-running shows should be no bigger than 1024 x 768. This is the limit for most projectors.
2. Save files as JPEGs with medium (7) compression. Files should be labeled: Lastname_firstinitial_01.JPG. For example, if your name is Bob Carey, your file should look like this: Carey_b_01.JPG
3. Videos should be saved in 1920 x 1080HD – h.264 MP4 in QuickTime.
4. Put the files in a folder labeled Lastname_firstname. For example, if your name is Bob Carey, the folder will be named: Carey_Bob
