- 4 first-year residents (\$30,264 + benefits)
- 4 second-year fellows (\$32,780 + benefits)
- Full-time (40 hours/week)
- Four ACPE units per year
- June 19, 2022 – June 18, 2023
- ACPE Application due by January 31, 2022

Four resident rotations include:

- Critical Care and Med/Surg Units
- Mental Health Inpatient Units
- Polytrauma Center (1 of 5 VAs in the nation)
- ALS Clinic
- Spinal Cord Injury Center
- Bereavement – individual and group
- Community Living Centers (skilled nursing care)
- Substance Use / Homeless Residential

Four fellowships include:

- **2 Mental Health** – inpatient locked down units, outpatient individual and group, rotating through three locations, including Psychosocial Rehabilitation and Recovery Center, PTSD Clinical Team, moral injury groups, and more
- **2 Palliative Care / Hospice** – to include Palliative Care Interdisciplinary Fellowship, inpatient/outpatient work, Community Living Center (skilled nursing), Hospice, & Bereavement outpatient groups for surviving family members

Possible CEC - one fellow may be designated a Certified Educator Candidate first year, with a GS-11 position for years 2 and 3 of the CEC Program

Required:

- U.S. citizenship
- Fully vaccinated (or authorized waiver)
- M.Div. from accredited seminary
- Endorsed or pursuing endorsement (recognized by Armed Forces Chaplains Board)
- Preferred: one unit of completed CPE
