SUMMER INTERNSHIP 2024

OVERVIEW

The Cornerstone Haskell pastoral internship is an opportunity to see regular, day-to-day pastoral life and provide a man who is considering aspiration as a pastor with an ecclesiological and pastoral grid for doing the work of ministry. How should the church be organized? Who should lead the church? Does the Bible discuss church membership? How does church polity affect the functionality of the local church? In addition to observing church life, the intern will spend much of their time conversing with the preaching pastor, books, church leaders, and members.

Through these conversations and their interaction with our church's life, the intern will discover what it means to build a church, not according to the latest cultural waves or "whatever works," but according to all the Bible says about our life together as the local church. Praise God that his Word is not silent on matters of ecclesiology and pastoring.

INTERNSHIP STRUCTURE AND WORK

The 2024 Summer Internship dates are May 19, 2024 – July 31, 2024 (*Flexibility available upon request*). The intern will spend much time shadowing the preaching pastor and fulfilling various duties and activities that will help foster an overall understanding of the different church ministries. Much of the intern's office time focuses on reading, writing, preparing, and discussing assignments.

HOUSING & STIPEND

Housing is available (*pending the time of application*) for the Summer of 2024. A stove is not available, but a microwave, fridge, and hot plate are available. In addition, the intern will receive a stipend of \$3000. The stipend will be divided equally into five checks deposited on the 15th and last day of each month. This internship does not provide health insurance.

A TYPICAL WEEK

In addition to the reading and writing assignments mentioned above, the intern's week includes mandatory attendance at all church meetings and gatherings, prayer times, intern discussions, weddings, wedding rehearsals, funerals, weekly service reviews, intern accountability and supervision times, and any spontaneous meetings that arise in a week. Interns can expect to serve in general office administration. A typical week runs from Sunday to Thursday, but special events can alter the usual week. Friday and Saturday are usually days off.

Additionally, we ask that the intern attend lunches/meetings with church leaders, deacons, and members that become available. These lunches/meetings provide the intern with an opportunity to learn about various aspects of the church's history and life.
